

Resolution to Recognize ALA Conference Services and Gale Cengage Learning for  
Providing Shuttle Bus Service Accommodating Attendees with Disabilities

Whereas, The Association of Specialized and Cooperative Library Agencies (ASCLA), a division of the American Library Association (ALA), and the ASCLA Library Services to Special Populations Section (LSSPS) and Accessibility Assembly have worked with ALA Conference Services on the accessibility of conference services for attendees with disabilities; and

Whereas, Gale Cengage Learning sponsored free shuttle service between all participating hotels and the San Diego Convention Center, debuting a special express route for sites close to the Convention Center for attendees requiring special assistance; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Council of the American Library Association (ALA) joins the Association of Specialized and Cooperative Library Agencies (ASCLA):

- (1) In commending ALA Conference Services for working with ASCLA Library Services to Special Populations Section (LSSPS) and the Accessibility Assembly to improve the accessibility of conference services for attendees with disabilities.
