Whereas the American Library Association and library automated industry lost a valued leader with the death of Paul Kay Sybrowsky on September 10, 2014;

Whereas he was a founding partner and President of Dynix;

Whereas he was President of Southern Virginia University from 2012 to 2014 and served on the Board of Trustees of Utah Valley University;

Whereas his leadership within Dynix revolutionized the way a vendor respected the contributions of their customers;

Whereas he, as President and CEO of Dynix, provided the majority of funding for the Snowbird Library Leadership program from 1990 to 1998 to ensure unique and exceptional training was available for young leaders in the library profession;

Whereas he served as Chair of the Board of Trustees of Utah Valley University from 1997 to 1999, Vice Chair from 1995 to 1997 and as a member of the executive board from 1995 to 2001;

Whereas he served as a commissioner for the Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges;

Whereas he served on the Board of Trustees of the Provo, Utah City Library from 1994 to 1997 and as Chair in 1997; and

Whereas Paul Sybrowsky was a loving husband, father and grandfather; now, therefore, be it
